SUN POLICY

At Ysgol y Foryd we acknowledge the importance of sun protection and want staff and pupils to enjoy the sun safely. We will work with staff, pupils and parents to achieve this through:

EDUCATION

All pupils will have at least one Sun Safety lesson per year.

We will talk about how to be Sun Safe during a themed assembly during the summer term

Guidance for Parents and guardians is in the school prospectus. A letter will also be sent during the summer term, or when required explaining what the school is doing about sun protection and how they can help.

Information on sun safety is provided in the staff room during the summer months.

PROTECTION

Shade:

We will encourage students to sit/play in the shade where it is available.

Trees have been planted around the school.

Sheltered areas have been built over recent years to provide shade.

Shade is provided by using umbrella over the tables and fabric over gazebos.

A permanent shade canopy is in place in the Foundation Quiet area.

Timetabling:

We encourage hats, sensible clothing and sunscreen are all worn during 11 and 3 to prevent sunburn.

Clothing:

Children are required to wear hats.

Teachers are encouraged to wear hats to provide a good role model.

Sunscreen:

Sunscreen use will be encouraged during summer at lunch breaks, during PE lessons and on school trips. Parents must provide this for their children who will be supervised while they apply this themselves.

We will monitor our progress and review the policy regularly.
